#### Installation Instructions for Aztec Trainer® Fired Heater Simulator

## **RE-INSTALLATION OR INSTALLATION OF NEW VERSION**

The control panel must be used to un-install any existing versions. The only file that should remain in the install folder is the key file. Any other files or folders must be erased before beginning the new installation!

#### Following are the steps required for installation of the software.

- 1. Read the following licensing agreement. If you choose to agree with the terms of the licensing agreement then proceed. If you choose not to, or cannot, abide by the agreement, cease the installation process and contact Aztec Engineering with any applicable questions.
- 2. Obtain a user name and a password by purchasing the software or applying for a free limited time demonstration license (<u>User Name and Password Request</u>).
- 3. Obtain a key (license) file by completing the form in step 2 above or providing Aztec Engineering LLC the volume serial number for the computer drive on which the simulator will be installed.
- 4. If a previous version of Trainer has been installed on your system, it is recommended that you uninstall the installation before proceeding with the new installation.
- 5. Follow Instructions Downloads.html.
- 6. Copy the Trainer.key file into your installation directory (most likely "c:\ProgramFiles\Trainer").
- 7. The installation should be complete.
- 8. It is recommended you delete Trainer.msi to avoid confusion with future versions of Trainer.
- 9. To start Trainer, go to the programs menu and "click" Aztec Programs.
